### **Community Hub**

Support for a multipurpose community hub in a central village position incorporating a variety of functions from inclusion of the library, Council Offices, coffee shop, CAB and community space. Create a focal point of amenities and improve and renovate Merton Way.

### **Toilet Scheme**

Community endorse the need of such a scheme and the collaboration of shops to support this scheme in the village and at the Broadway.
